<ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Demonstrate the ability to critically and systematically integrate knowledge and analyse, assess and deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations even with limited information</i><i>Demonstrate the ability to identify and formulate issues critically, autonomously and creatively as well as to plan and, using appropriate methods, undertake advanced tasks within predetermined time frames and so contribute to the formation of knowledge as well as the ability to evaluate this work.</i>

- *Demonstrate the ability in speech and writing both nationally and internationally to report clearly and discuss his or her conclusions and the knowledge and arguments on which they are based in dialogue with different audiences, and*
- *Demonstrate the skills required for participation in research and development work or autonomous employment in some other qualified capacity.*

Judgment and approach

- *Demonstrate the ability to make assessments in the main field of study informed by relevant disciplinary, social and ethical issues and also to demonstrate awareness of ethical aspects of research and development work.*
- *Demonstrate insight into the possibilities and limitations of research, its role in society and the responsibility of the individual for how it is used.*
- *Demonstrate the ability to identify the personal need for further knowledge and take responsibility for his or her ongoing learning.*

Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)

The purpose of this course is for the students to understand and learn how to work with global health issues based on the notion that health is influenced by sustainable development and vice versa. It introduces the concepts of sustainable health and sustainable development. The course builds on the fact that the global sustainability challenges are complex and integrated with each other and affect both current and future generations as well as the planet.

The course must include:

- *Descriptions of the concepts of sustainable health and sustainable development.*
- *Description of the 2030 Agenda and its predecessors and discussion on possible successors.*
- *Analysis of how the UN Sustainable Development Goals are interrelated and which implications this potentially has.*
- *The concept wicked problems and the implications for sustainable health and development*
- *Analysis of expected effects on health of the major sustainability challenges such as climate change, extreme poverty and inequality and in-depth reflections on how these can be prevented and responded to.*
- *Discussions on how the sustainability challenges affect health systems and health care.*

- *Reflections on how multisectoral collaboration contributes to improved health and sustainable development.*
- *Practical skills (methods / tools) on how to use systems thinking to find solutions to sustainable health and development challenges.*
- *Presentation of the most important arenas for global health diplomacy and discussion on how it is carried through to forward sustainable health and development.*
- *Tools for multisectoral collaboration, to meet challenges and find sustainable solutions to complex wicked problems.*
