Knowledge and understanding

 Demonstrate specialised methodological knowledge in the main field of study.

Competence and skills

- Demonstrate the ability to critically and systematically integrate knowledge and analyse, assess and deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations even with limited information.
- Demonstrate the ability to identify and formulate issues critically, autonomously and creatively as well as to plan and, using appropriate methods, undertake advanced tasks within predetermined time frames and so contribute to the formation of knowledge as well as the ability to evaluate this work.

Judgment and approach

 Demonstrate the ability to make assessments in the main field of study informed by relevant disciplinary, social and ethical issues and also to demonstrate awareness of ethical aspects of research and development work. Demonstrate insight into the possibilities and limitations of research, its role in society and the responsibility of the individual for how it is used.

Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)

This course will provide in-depth knowledge on advanced qualitative theories and methods such as co-design and participatory methods and how they are applied in global health research and practice. The course will further deepen knowledge of theories and approaches to qualitative data analysis. The course will draw on a range of case studies to discuss, analyse and critically reflect on the benefits and limitations of qualitative methods. The course will further engage with concepts of trustworthiness, reflexivity and ethics throughout.

The course must include:

- Advanced qualitative data analysis knowledge and skills, including working with different inductive approaches, and deductive approaches drawing on theoretical frameworks.
- Foundational knowledge and skills regarding visual data collection methods (photovoice, community mapping) and analysis.
- Foundational knowledge and skills regarding observational methods and analysis, including the principles of ethnographic research and rapid ethnographies, as well as more structured approaches to observational methods used in public health research.
- Basic knowledge and skills regarding analysis of secondary data, including social media and internet research.
- Advanced ethics, trustworthiness and reflexivity will be integrated throughout the different components of the course. This will be done with a strong global health lens.
