- *Demonstrate insight into the possibilities and limitations of research, its role in society and the responsibility of the individual for how it is used.*

Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)

This course provides explores the development, implementation, and evaluation of health interventions, emphasizing participatory design and co-design to ensure cultural sensitivity and effectiveness. Multiple examples will be shared from global contexts including low and middle-income settings. It covers the principles of Patient and Public Involvement (PPI) for enhancing intervention acceptance, alongside a focus on impact evaluation through individual and cluster trials, distinguishing between pragmatic and explanatory trials for real-world effectiveness and theoretical insights. The course takes a holistic approach to intervention development, implementation and evaluation and will provide students with an introduction to:

- *Participatory methods including co-design*
- *Patient & public involvement*
- *Formative trial methods and piloting*
- *Types of impact evaluation (individual, cluster trials, quasi-experimental stepped-wedge and time-series)*
- *Implementation science, process evaluations and mixed methods*
- *Hybrid effectiveness-implementation studies*
- *Economic evaluation*
