<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><i>demonstrate specialised methodological knowledge in the main field of study.</i></li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><i>demonstrate the ability to critically and systematically integrate knowledge and analyse, assess and deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations even with limited information.</i></li><li><i>demonstrate the ability to identify and formulate issues critically, autonomously and creatively as well as to plan and, using appropriate methods, undertake advanced tasks within predetermined time frames and so contribute to the formation of knowledge as well as the ability to evaluate this work.</i></li><li><i>demonstrate the skills required for participation in research and development work or autonomous employment in some other qualified capacity.</i></li></ul>

<p><b>Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)</b></p> <p><i>The purpose of this course is to allow students to integrate theoretical and methodological knowledge with acquired competence and skills in an internship project practiced within a research group, company or organization doing work relevant to global health. Students will plan, carry out and evaluate a project. Students have to secure an internship position with a research group, company or organization before enrolling for this course.</i></p> <p><i>The course must:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Teach students how to integrate effectively into a workplace, understand organizational culture, and align personal project goals with organizational objectives.</i></li> <li>• <i>Foster an understanding among students of how global health actors work with projects in practice.</i></li> <li>• <i>Allow students to apply or observe the application of methods, skills and tools taught in earlier courses, including project planning principles and tools and financial considerations (through budgeting or grant writing).</i></li> <li>• <i>Give students exposure to interdisciplinary strategies and approaches.</i></li> <li>• <i>Teach students to navigate and reflect on ethical considerations in a real-world setting.</i></li> </ul> <p><i>Give students the opportunity to reflect on their experiences, challenges faced, and the applicability of theoretical knowledge</i></p>
