<i>Competence and skills</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Demonstrate the ability to critically and systematically integrate knowledge and analyse, assess and deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations even with limited information.</i><i>Demonstrate the ability to identify and formulate issues critically, autonomously and creatively as well as to plan and, using appropriate methods, undertake advanced tasks within predetermined time frames and so contribute to the formation of knowledge as well as the ability to evaluate this work.</i>
Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)

This course is an introduction to evidence synthesis and is designed to provide an overview of the techniques and strategies used to synthesize scientific evidence. Students will learn how to evaluate and interpret evidence from multiple sources and use it to draw meaningful conclusions.

The course must:

- *Provide an overview of different types of systematic reviews (scoping reviews, meta-analysis, critical appraisal).*
- *Provide an overview of the role/application of evidence synthesis in policy and practice.*
- *Provide an introduction to misinformation and infodemics and strategies used to address these.*
