Knowledge and understanding <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Demonstrate specialised methodological knowledge in the main field of study.</i>
Competence and skills <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Demonstrate the ability to critically and systematically integrate knowledge and analyse, assess and deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations even with limited information.</i><i>Demonstrate the ability to identify and formulate issues critically, autonomously and creatively as well as to plan and, using appropriate methods, undertake advanced tasks within predetermined time frames and so contribute to the formation of knowledge as well as the ability to evaluate this work.</i>
Judgment and approach <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Demonstrate the ability to make assessments in the main field of study informed by relevant disciplinary, social and ethical issues and also to demonstrate awareness of ethical aspects of research and development work.</i>

- *Demonstrate insight into the possibilities and limitations of research, its role in society and the responsibility of the individual for how it is used.*

Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)

This course will prepare students to contribute to multidisciplinary and international efforts in preparedness, response, recovery, and learning from health crises and disasters through both theoretical and practical trainings. The course will draw on a range of case studies, practical exercises, simulations, interactive lectures, and discussion seminars. The course will engage with concepts of hazards, vulnerability, coping capacity, and health system resilience. Ethical dilemmas in health crises and disasters will also be critically reflected upon during the course.

The course must include:

- *Foundational knowledge of different types of health crises and disasters, and analysis of the role of health systems and key stakeholders in preparedness, response, recovery, and learning.*
- *Foundational knowledge and skills in analyzing health system resilience and its applications in different settings.*
- *Critical reflections on the concepts of hazards, exposures, vulnerabilities, and coping capacity.*
- *Advanced knowledge and skills in conducting needs and risk assessments to help prioritize, plan, implement, and monitor public health interventions.*
- *Advanced knowledge and skills in identifying, interpreting, and summarizing information from different data sources to detect, plan, monitor, and respond to health crises and disasters.*
- *Basic knowledge and skills in risk communication during health crises.*
- *Basic knowledge and skills in outbreak investigation methods and response.*
- *Critical reflections on ethical dilemmas in health crises and disasters including when resources are limited to meet vital public health needs, or where there is limited information for prioritization and decision-making.*
