<ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>demonstrate knowledge and understanding in the main field of study, including both broad knowledge of the field and a considerable degree of specialised knowledge in certain areas of the field as well as insight into current research and development work, and</i><i>demonstrate specialised methodological knowledge in the main field of study.</i>
<i>Competence and skills</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>demonstrate the ability to critically and systematically integrate knowledge and analyse, assess and deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations even with limited information.</i><i>demonstrate the ability to identify and formulate issues critically, autonomously and creatively as well as to plan and, using appropriate methods, undertake advanced tasks within predetermined time frames and so contribute to the formation of knowledge as well as the ability to evaluate this work.</i>

- *demonstrate the ability in speech and writing both nationally and internationally to report clearly and discuss his or her conclusions and the knowledge and arguments on which they are based in dialogue with different audiences, and*
- *demonstrate the skills required for participation in research and development work or autonomous employment in some other qualified capacity.*

Judgment and approach

- *demonstrate the ability to make assessments in the main field of study informed by relevant disciplinary, social and ethical issues and also to demonstrate awareness of ethical aspects of research and development work.*
- *demonstrate insight into the possibilities and limitations of research, its role in society and the responsibility of the individual for how it is used, and*
- *demonstrate the ability to identify the personal need for further knowledge and take responsibility for his or her ongoing learning*

Beskrivning av kurs (design, ämnes- och professions integrering, etc.)

The purpose of this course is for students to learn how a research project is developed, implemented, analysed and presented as well as how to critically appraise and evaluate their own and others' research work. See also KI's general criteria for assessing degree projects (Dnr 1-498/2023).

The course must:

- *Accommodate different project modalities and designs common in Global Health and taught in the courses of the programme, including quantitative and qualitative methods as well as mixed methods, applied to primary or secondary data, including data from extensive literature reviews or other types of evidence synthesis.*
- *Foster an understanding of how a research project is developed from problem identification to development of study design and implementation of data collection.*
- *Teach students to apply appropriate methods for data collection and analysis, with due regard to validity and reliability.*
- *Teach students to generate a research report that documents the research process, including the interpretation of data and its implications for global health.*
- *Teach students to assess and reflect on ethical considerations with regard to their own and others' research work.*
- *Teach students to defend their own research findings in a public seminar.*

- *Teach students to evaluate their own and others' research work.*
